Adjustment: Sporting Regulations – Article 4. EVENT and Article 14. RUNNING OF THE EVENT

- The Event will comprise two races in the final phase named «Pre-Final» and «Final». The distance of the Pre-Final and Final, from the starting signal to the chequered flag, will be equal to the minimum number of full laps necessary for reaching the respective distances of 20km 18km and 30km 18km. The chequered flag will be shown to the leading kart when it crosses the finishing line («the Line») at the end of the lap during which that distance is reached. The Line consists in a single line across the track. The final classification of the Event will be the classification of the Final.
- 14.1.3 Final phase: 34 Drivers will compete in the final phase over a total distance of <del>50</del> 36 km, which will be run according to the following format: Pre-Final and Final.
  - \* Pre-Final (20 **18km**): Starting positions according to the results of the qualifying practice.
  - \* Final (30 18km): Starting positions determined by the classification of the Pre-Final.
