

2017 MACAO INTERNATIONAL KART GRAND PRIX

AAMC CUP REGULATIONS

Article 1. Organizer

The 2017 AAMC CUP is organized and sanctioned by the Automobile General Association Macao - China (AAMC). The aim of the Event is to promote and develop the karting sport in Macao.

Article 2. REGULATIONS

The final text of these Sporting Regulations shall be the English version which will be used should any dispute arise as to their interpretation.

Article 3. GENERAL UNDERTAKINGS

3.1 All Drivers, Entrants and Officials participating in the Event undertake, on behalf of themselves, their employees and agents, to observe all the provisions of the International Sporting Code («the Code»), the Karting Technical Regulations («the Technical Regulations»), the General Prescriptions applicable to the CIK-FIA Karting international Events and Championships, Cups and Trophies («the General Prescriptions»), the Specific Prescriptions applicable to the CIK-FIA Karting Championships, Cups and Trophies («the Specific Prescriptions»), the Supplementary Regulations of the Event concerned and these Sporting Regulations.

Article 4. EVENT

4.1 The Event is an National event open to all participants.

4.2 The Event will comprise two races in the final phase named «Pre-Final» and «Final». The distance of the Pre-Final and Final, each from the starting signal to the chequered flag, will be equal to the minimum number of full laps necessary for reaching the respective distances of 18km. The chequered flag will be shown to the leading kart when it crosses the finishing line («the Line») at the end of the lap during which that distance is reached. The Line consists in a single line across the track. The final classification of the Event will be the classification of the Final.

Article 5. EVENT SCHEDULE AND PROGRAM

5.1 The Event will take place in Macao from 07th – 10th December 2017.

5.2 Event Program (TBA)

Article 6. CIRCUIT

Macao Karting Circuit, Coloane (Estrada Seac Pai Van Kartodromo de Coloane, Macao)

Article 7. OFFICIALS

All Officials and Track Marshals will be appointed by AAMC.

Article 8. CLASSIFICATION

8.1 The classification of the Event will be that of the Final.

8.2 The title of AAMC CUP Driver will be awarded to the Driver who has won the Final.

8.3 If the Final is stopped under Article 2.21 of the General Prescriptions and cannot be restarted, and if less than 75% of the scheduled distance have been covered, the title of Winner of the AAMC CUP will not be awarded.

Article 9. ENTRANTS' APPLICATIONS AND ENTRY FEE

9.1 Applicants must hold valid Driver's License and the necessary authorisations (visas) issued by their ASNs affiliated to the CIK-FIA appropriate to the race. Appropriate and valid Team License is required for team entry.

9.2 The closing date for entries of the event is at 03rd November 2017.

9.3 The Organizer has the right to refuse any entry, of vehicle or driver, in which case, the reason(s) for such a refusal will not be notified to the competitor; however the entry fee will be refunded. Applicants must provide all the materials, information and statements stipulated in the entry forms at the time of submission.

9.4 Entry Fees

- For this event: MOP500.00

- 9.5 Applications shall include:
- 9.5.1 Confirmation that the applicant has read and understood the Code, the General Prescriptions, the Specific Regulations, the Appendices, the Technical Regulations and the Sporting Regulations and agrees, on his own behalf and on behalf of everyone associated with his participation in the Event, to respect them;
 - 9.5.2 The name, contact details and datas of the driver, valid driver's license number and name of the team if applicable.
 - 9.5.3 Two (2) Photographs of the driver(s).
 - 9.5.4 The entry fee.
- 9.6 Entry forms that are incomplete or that were sent by fax or email only shall not be taken into consideration.

Article 10. ELIGIBLE DRIVERS

- 10.1 All Drivers participating in the Event must possess the appropriate and valid Driver's License as required by the entered race.
- 10.2 Drivers who are under 18 years of age are required to have the agreement and authorization of their parents or guardian for their entry and participation.
- 10.3 The Organizer shall have the right to accept the participation of a driver who does not meet the entry requirements to a race of any race class as it may deem fit according to the driver's racing records and experiences.

Article 11. ELIGIBLE KARTS AND EQUIPMENT

- 11.1 The Event is reserved for KZ karts, as defined by the Technical Regulations.
- 11.2 No change of equipment will be allowed after the scheduled Scrutineering period.
- 11.3 Each Driver will be entitled to submit to Scrutineering the following equipment:
 - Number of chassis: 2, of the same make
 - Number of engines: 2, of the same make

11.4 As from Qualifying Practice, each Driver may have the following equipment:

Number of chassis: 2 (the 2 marked at Scrutineering)

Number of engines: 2 (the 2 marked at Scrutineering)

Article 12. Briefing

12.1 Article-2.18 of the CIK-FIA General Prescription should be referred.

12.2 The presence of all participating drivers and entrants are mandatory throughout the briefing under pain of a sanction or even a possible exclusion from the event.

12.3 No questions other than those relating to the actual conduct of the races will be addressed in the briefing.

12.4 Any driver who fails to attend and sign the attendance sheet will be subject to fine of MOP500.00 cash payable before practice starts. Failure to pay will result in exclusion.

Article 13. GENERAL SAFETY

Article 2.14 of the General Prescriptions.

Article 14. RUNNING OF THE EVENT

14.1 The Event will comprise Free Practice, Qualifying Practice and a final phase as a minimum.

14.1.1 Free Practice: Reserved for those Drivers having passed the Sporting Checks and Scrutineering.

14.1.2 Qualifying Practice: Article 18 B of the Specific Prescriptions.

14.1.3 Final phase: 34 Drivers will compete in the final phase over a total distance of 50 km, which will be run according to the following format: Pre-Final and Final.

* Pre-Final (20 km): Starting positions according to the results of the qualifying practice.

* Final (30 km): Starting positions determined by the classification of the Pre-Final.

Article 15. STARTING GRIDS

Article 2.19 of the General Prescriptions.

Article 16. STARTING PROCEDURE

16.1 Article 2.20 of the General Prescriptions.

16.2 Type of starts: standing starts for karts with gearboxes, as defined in Article 2.20 of the General Prescriptions.

16.3 The Stewards may use any video or electronic system likely to help them to take a decision. The Stewards' decisions may supersede those taken by Judges of Fact. Any infringement to the provisions of the Code or of these Sporting Regulations relating to the starting procedure may entail the exclusion of the Driver concerned from the Event.

Article 19. FINISH AND PARC FERMÉ

Article 20. INCIDENTS

Incidents are sanctioned as referred in Appendix A of these Sporting Regulations and Articles 2.24 of the General Prescriptions.

Article 21. PROTESTS AND APPEALS

21.1 Protests shall be made in accordance with the Code; within 30 minutes of the Official publication of the results and accompanied by a fee of cash MOP2,000.00 Each item under protest must be made separately.

21.2 In case of an entrant/ driver to entrant/ driver technical protest, an additional bond of MOP 2,000.00 will be lodged with the Secretary of the Meeting and returned to the protester if the protest upheld or paid to the protested team in the case of an invalid protest.

21.3 Appeals must be referred in Articles 25 of the Specific Prescriptions. Appeal fee will be in cash of MOP 40,000.00.

Article 22. FINE

Any fine inflicted by the Stewards shall be paid within the time limit as stated by the Stewards or 48 hours to the Organizer, whichever is sooner. Failing in paying the fine on time will be subject to further penalty.

Article 23. AWARDS

1st place WINNER Trophy

2nd place SECOND Trophy

3rd place THIRD Trophy

- * The reward drivers must attend the prize-giving ceremony on the podium in full racing overall and abide by the podium procedures as directed by the Organizer.

APPENDIX B - Technical Regulations

A) Chassis

All chassis homologated by CIK-FIA are authorized and allowed despite of their year of homologation.

B) Engine

For the engine which is 125cc with gearbox. Only reed-valve intakes are authorized. All engine homologated by CIK-FIA are accepted and allowed despite of their year of homologation.

C) Gearbox

All gearbox homologated by CIK-FIA are authorized and allowed despite of their year of homologation. Minimum 3 and maximum 6 ratios.
